The data source for this section are the hourly ATR files for 1992 and 1995, submitted to the FHWA by the states in support of Traffic Volume Trends. The weekly pattern for the nationwide analysis remains constant over the two study years. All of the charts in this section show the traffic pattern, measured as a percent of the average weekly traffic that occurs during any given hour. The graphs all run from Sunday to Saturday and measure each hour as a percent of the weekly total. In this way, all of the graphs are normalized. Figures 2. 3. 1 and 2. 3. 2 show the nationwide, weekly traffic patterns, urban and rural, in the two study years. From these figures, it can be seen that days of the week follow...
